Action Taken Reports

1) Catchment Area Treatment (CAT)

CAT under Phase-II (freely draining and very high and high degraded area) area) comprising 43125 Ha. of 35 approved watersheds the treatment of 40175 Ha. Area of 24 watersheds also completed. Remaining balance is only 2950 ha. area.

Total 5620 ha. area was proposed for area and drainage line treatments (watershed)

Works will be completed before onset of monsoon.



2) Compensatory Afforestation.

Government of Maharashtra has proposed **174 ha** degraded forest land for Compensatory Afforestation against remaining **87 ha** non-forest land, which is not suitable for plantation. Forest department has initiated the pre-plantation works and up till now 80% work are completed the rest of the works of planting will be carried out in 2017 rains.

3) Clearance by Environmental Sub Group

Mr. Afroz Ahmed, Member (E&R), NCA has informed that Environmental Clearance has been granted. Website of Environment Department is being updated in respect of environment works.

Catchment Area treatment



- CAT under **Phase I** (directly draining very high and high degraded area) is already completed. It comprised of 23295 Ha.
(Forest Department-20283 Ha+Agriculture Department-3012 Ha).
- CAT under **Phase-II** (freely draining and very high and high degraded area) comprising 43125 Ha. of 35 approved watersheds the treatment of 40175 Ha. Area of 24 watersheds also completed. Remaining balance is only 2950 ha. area.
- The Water Resources Department, Government of Maharashtra has made available funds of Rs. 668.41 lacs to complete these works.
- Forest Department has initiated the balance CAT related works out of which 65% works are completed up till now and planned to complete these works before monsoon.

Compensatory Afforestation



- Total Compensatory Afforestation in lieu of submergence was 19466 Ha. (includes 12977 Ha. Degraded Forest and 6489 Ha. Non-Forest). Out of this work completed in 19379 Ha.(12977 D.F.+ 6402 N.F.).
- Government of Maharashtra has proposed **174 ha** degraded forest land for Compensatory Afforestation against remaining **87 ha** non-forest land, which is not suitable for plantation.
- The Water Resources Department, Government of Maharashtra has made available funds of Rs. 341.53 lacs (Out of Rs. 572.26 lacs) for balance 174 ha. Compensatory Afforestation.
- Forest department has initiated the pre-plantation works and up till now 80% work are completed the rest of the works of planting will be carried out in 2017 rains.



Notification of Non Forest area as Reserved/Protected Forest

Government of Maharashtra has notified **10,675 ha** (100% of the target) Non forest area as Protected/Reserved forest in Dhule, Aurangabad, Nashik, Yavatmal and Amravati Circles.

CAT in 9 Micro-Watershed



- Administrative approval given for 9 micro watersheds:
7 from Akkalkuwa tehsil and 2 from Akkrani tehsil of Nandurbar district .
- Total **5620 ha.** area was proposed for area and drainage line treatments having project cost of Rs.1146 Lakh.
- The Watershed works have been completed on 2459 ha. area. The expenditure incurred was Rs.280.44 lakh.
- The funds of Rs.457.13 lakh for treatment of 3146 ha. area have been made available to District Superintending Agriculture officer, Nandurbar by State Water Resources Department.
- The watershed works will be completed before onset of monsoon.

Comprehensive Health Services Delivery Plan



(a) Health Services in 11 Rehabilitated Colonies

- In Nandrubar District in Sardar Sarovar submerged area there are 9 villages of Akkalkuwa Taluka and 24 villages of Dhadgaon Taluka. Likewise such 33 villages and 65 padas are in submerged region catering a population of 7179.
- This affected area people have been rehabilitated in Shahada, Taloda and Akkalkuwa District in 11 rehabilitation colonies.
- Out of these 11 Rehabilitated Colonies, Narmada Nagar (Valheri) has all sanctioned posts. However, Dekati, Rozwa, Amoni and Amlī has few posts vacant. But the centers are functioning. For the remaining 6 rehabilitated colonies namely, Gopalipur, Tarhavad, Vadchil, Chikali, Wadi and Katarde Digar, the sanctioning of post is under process. However, services have been provided with the help of concerned contractual Medical Officers and health staffs.

(b) Health Services in adjoining 33 villages and 65 hamlets

- In this area, total 6 PHCs, 10 Sub-centers, 35 Hon. Medical Officers, 33 ASHA Workers and 26 Trained Dais are rendering available health services.
- Over and above these, two floating dispensaries and 3 boat ambulances have been made available for providing basic health services to the nearby Sardar Sarovar Bank Area.

(c) Floating Dispensaries

- In 2004, European Commission has provided two barges as floating dispensaries which are functioning in Akkalkuwa and Dhadgaon.
- On these barges, 1 MO, 1 ANM, 1 Lab Technician, 1 Pharmacy Officer, 1 Attendant, 1 Sailor and 1 Barge Driver are provided.
- Rs.15,000/- per month sanctioned for petrol and diesel and Rs.20,000/- per month for remuneration of Sailor and Barge Driver.

(d) Boat Ambulance

- Public Health Department, State of Maharashtra has provided 3 floating ambulances in 2015-16 under National Health Mission to the people affected from Sardar Sarovar Project. For this floating ambulance, 1 MO, 1 ANM, 1 Peon and 1 Driver posts have been sanctioned on contractual basis under National Health Mission.

(e) Flying Squads (Bharari Pathak)

- The Government of Maharashtra has sanctioned total 15 Flying Squads (Bharari Pathak) as per Government Resolution dated 9th February 2017, for Nandurbar District in which budget provision for remuneration of contractual staff, P.O.L. for vehicles and medicines is included.
